Footnotes

CYRENE hustled to the front, was pressed briefly by RAISE THE WEIGHT, put that rival away near the quarter pole, drew off easily from upper stretch, won under wraps as much the best. RAISE THE WEIGHT pressed the winner briefly, chased from mid turn, came three wide pursuing the winner into the lane, never threatened and was all out holding on to the place position coming to the wire. PROPER N PRIM was hustled early, raced along the rail throughout, received severe left handed stick in the lane, just got up to gain the show position, hard effort. STORMY RAIN well placed early, put to a drive while running between foes on the bend, never menaced, bested others vying for minor awards. SLEWS MOUNTAIN GAL unhurried early, came six wide entering the stretch, was hard ridden but failed to factor. IMA GIVEN settled early, rushed a four wide bid at the quarter pole, failed to sustain rally and leveled off mid stretch. WHERESTHMONYMAGGIE lacked speed, offered little, dropped far off the pace leaving the quarter pole, no factor.
