RED TWENTY TWO raced evenly early advancing to contention three wide on the turn, found belated surge running at BOLTEN N STREAKIN getting a nose up on the wire. BOLTEN N STREAKIN was sent clear holding the lead under pressure on the turn, shook clear in upper stretch digging in along the inside missing in the last jump. RIGHT ON QUEUE slow early gained four wide on the turn looming at mid track in upper stretch, responded late making a final surge to no avail. SET TO ROLL away slowly was rushed to bid five deep on the turn, came six wide in upper stretch weakening under a drive. YES IT IS was hustled out chasing then pressuring from the two path on the turn, wavered into upper stretch dropping off while finishing evenly. SHERIFF FARLEY slow early came five wide in upper stretch remaining no factor. BRAHMS GOLD was put to a drive early, made no headway on the turn then gave way into upper stretch. LETS GET STARTED fractious in the gate would stumble at the start, rushed along inside would wilt to upper stretch. BADGER'S TRUTH was always outrun.
