Footnotes

DOROTHY'S DIAMOND stalked early ranging up three wide wide to grab the lead on the turn, moved off in upper stretch finishing under a mild drive. KUFF EM tracked along the inside early angling out four wide on the turn, bid from mid track in upper stretch giving all to salvage place. GOLANI RULES broke alertly pressuring the pace into the turn, overpowered by DOROTHY'S DIAMOND near the quarter pole would chase into upper stretch coming up short along the inside. OOHRAH SEMPER FI off slowly stayed back through the turn, came seven wide in upper stretch angling in a bit while vying evenly late. SIX MILLER'S saved ground while outrun through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch joining the fray for place finishing evenly. WOKE UP RUNNIN' slow early came six wide in upper stretch lacking late response. MOORE HILL saved ground playing no factor. CAT AND CUSTARD pressured the early pace then wavered on the turn wilting near the rail in upper stretch.
