LIVEINTHEPRESENT dueled to the half thru very soft fractions, urged leaving the quarter pole, had plenty left to quickly draw off, won convincingly being ridden out. MAASTRICHT sat patient tracking a soft pace, launched rally coming four wide entering the stretch, angled to the rail at the eighth pole, surged willingly to snare second place. ALRIGHT NOW vied running along the rail to the half through thru a pedestrian pace, could not keep pace turning for home, was angled out to the four path giving chase, weakened mid stretch and settled for the show position. KWAME lacked speed racing at mid track, did find belated stride mid stretch but never menaced. PLEASANT COMPANY settled in the second flight, traveled between foes on the bend, failed to respond when roused, no threat. KEEP IT SWINGING was five wide going into the first turn, continued running mid track, varied little never factoring. MY BALLET unhurried from the gate and angled to the rail, trailed throughout, past one weary foe in the lane in a dull effort. CLAYVILLE flashed speed giving chase to the half racing along the rail, dropped off at the quarter pole, finished spent.
