Footnotes

BULL'S EAR came out bumping NO MORE TAX at the break, sent to contest the early pace into the turn, edged clear near the 1/4 pole, challenged from the inside by CHAR'S STILL HERE in upper stretch, dug in holding firm late under urging. CHAR'S STILL HERE raced evenly off the inside to the turn, angled to a vacated rail nearing the 1/4 pole, cut the corner challenging BULL'S EAR in upper stretch, was rebuffed late remaining willing. CHEMISTRY stalked reasonably close up, emerged to take aim at BULL'S EAR on the turn, loomed abreast rivals setting down 4 wide for the drive, hard ridden to wire lacking closing punch. TRICK YOUR MAN unhurried from the gate, prompted to bid 5 wide into the turn, gained on the outside while under a drive near the 1/4 pole, lost momentum in upper stretch, was put away late. PASSIONFORLUCK rushed to the front end, shuffled back from between horses on the turn, gave even response through the lane posing no late threat. NO MORE TAX bumped by BULL'S EAR causing rider to steady at the break, spotted the field trailing to mid turn, swung wide into lane with little to offer. VICTORIA'S IMAGE unruly in the gate throwing the rider causing a short delay, broke slowly, struggled throughout. ALI THE CAT broke sharply pressuring BULL'S EAR on the early pace, began to waver mid turn, wilted inside the 1/4 pole.
