PYRITE BOB set a well rated pace, held an uncontested lead to the quarter pole, threatened by ABBY RENEE at the quarter pole, dug in from upper stretch, A SLICK CHIC also joined the battle at the eighth pole, PYRITE BOB refused to lose prevailing in an all out drive. ABBY RENAE raced four wide into the first turn, continued on stalking PYRITE BOB traveling three wide down the backside, set down at the quarter pole, almost drew even top of the lane, could never get by and came to wire vying between foes in a three way duel, was repulsed by the winner then just held place in a hard effort. A SLICK CHIC settled down the backside, launched rally from the quarter pole, came four wide into the lane, vied abreast foes a sixteenth out, was outgamed in last jumps. PHYL'S NOTEBOOK unhurried early, urged leaving the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, showed belated action cutting into the margin deep stretch but was no real threat. LADY REDCHECKS tracked under a rating, roused mid turn, failed to respond never menacing. RESERVE A WIN lacked speed and raced inside throughout, failed to factor. STUDIO ONE lacked speed racing mid track throughout, offered little.
