Footnotes

DEPUTY ON DUTY rated while racing four to five wide going down the backside, angled to the rail leaving the far turn, bid near the quarter pole, vied in a three way duel, edged clear in upper stretch, was kept to task to hold safe at the finish. TWOBITHUSTLER was rated back entering the backstretch, sat patient to the quarter pole, came five wide into the lane, closed willingly in deep stretch, missed in a hard try. LEWIE D hustled off and set a pressured pace, headed from both sides mid turn, ceded grudgingly, good effort. STRIKE TWO well placed tracking the pace along the rail, angled out five wide under a drive entering the stretch, lacked late kick. SILVER LABEL made a slight hop as the gate opened, quickly rushed up to stalk, traveled four to five wide going down the backside, rallied mid turn, took a slim lead at the quarter pole, duelled from upper stretch, weakened late, bested rest. CRUISING SPEED was always outrun, offered little. A DEVIL OF A TRIP was urged early, pressed to the half, began to fade coming to the quarter pole, finished weary. POINT WHO was quickly outrun, continued to lose ground past the half, lost contact with the field by mid turn.
