Footnotes

SUNSHINE BO stalked throughout, bid in tandem mid turn, battled in four way duel at the quarter pole racing three wide, fought hard in the lane and got the nod on the wire being fully extended. PASTER'S BAD HABIT tracked the pace racing off the rail, rallied four wide mid turn, dueled abreast foes entering the stretch, had a head lead mid stretch, was hard ridden but got out noddod on the wire, missed in a game effort. DRUMSTREET settled in mid pack, gained momentum entering the stretch coming five wide, finished in willing manner. GIMMEAWINN pressed for the lead soon after the start, bid in tandem running between rivals at the quarter pole, fought hard to deep stretch, tired in last jumps besting rest. FAR EAST GOLD hustled to the front, set a pressured pace racing along the rail, battled to top of the lane, had enough mid stretch giving way. BOLDCHARMER raced wide going into the first turn, trailed to the quarter pole, angled a bit entering the stretch, showed belated interest to improve placing. ANDY O saved ground running in the second flight, failed to respond when asked for more. LUCKYALLMYLIFE lacked speed, raced off the rail throughout, never factored. F W B'S LEGACY was well placed running along the rail, chased around the bend, lacked rally and faded in the lane.
