Footnotes

PAULNPAUL was hustled up early chasing BEARS GENERAL through the turn drawing even alongside the leader in upper stretch, bore down the final sixteenth gradually edging by to win clear. BEARS GENERAL broke sharply moving a solid pace racing away from the rail through the turn, collared in upper stretch would battle back before ceding grudgingly in the closing yards. CHANGE PLEASE stalked the pace moving evenly through the turn extending into upper stretch, hard ridden down the lane made no headway while holding position. FIREBALL JACK slow early lost ground to upper stretch improving mildly while eight wide. TRAVELEZE chased early then dropped off on the turn going evenly the rest of the way. SCARY TRIP veered in missing the break, would labor after. LOOKOFANEAGLE a step slow was angled inside to upper stretch giving little response there. PARKER VALLEY failed to respond. DAKOTA FREEWAY was always outrun. EXCESSIVELY GROOVY had brief foot before folding up on the turn.
