CHIEF WINDSONG broke sharply pressing to a short lead on the turn, dug in four wide down the stretch holding firm. SUMMER GUIDE a step slow early was rushed up four wide on the turn, bidding from mid track down the lane proved no match for CHIEF WINDSONG late. KYLE'S TREASURY slow early was circled out to upper stretch, improved there seven wide. GARY'S BOOMER off slowly was outrun through the turn, lost ground to upper stretch gaining belatedly eight wide. AMERICAN INFLUENCE stalked then chased the pace through the turn, extended to upper stretch would weaken. IMPASS slow early played no factor along the inside. AARONS LAST DANCE chased early then dropped off four wide on the turn. MYSTERY HUNTER sent hard, pressed on the inside through the turn, then gave way in upper stretch. GREY MIRAGE was always outrun finishing wide.
