MORE HUMOR broke sharply then was soon headed by HONOUR ABOVE SELF, matched strides to the quarter pole, edged away top of the lane while angling to the rail, was put to a stiff drive a sixteenth out to prevail as the lead was diminishing. TEXAS HOLLADAY was bumped by HONOUR ABOVE SELF leaving the gate, settled running mid track, came five wide into the lane, closed hard in deep stretch just missing in a very game effort. ANOTHER VOW rated early running along the rail, rallied top of the lane, improved placing and rider stood up with seventy yards to go misjudging the wire, quickly sat back down and was ridden out to the wire besting rest. KENNY'S LAD was urged leaving the gate but gave little response, trailed to the quarter pole, swung five wide entering the stretch, showed belated action but never menaced. HONOUR ABOVE SELF broke in bumping TEXAS HOLLADAY at the break, quickly rushed up pressing MORE HUMOR for the run down the backside, alternated to the quarter pole, could not keep pace top of the lane gave way in the drive. KEEP THE CHIEF hustled early and gave chase to the quarter pole, began to give way in upper stretch, no late factor.
