**Footnotes**

MEGHA patiently ridden while saving ground down the backstretch, asked while angling out mid turn, came three wide taking aim entering the stretch, wore down POWER GRACE to take the lead at the sixteenth pole and won drawing off. POWER GRACE hustled into the first turn to set all the pace, maintained a clear advantage throughout, began to tire in mid stretch, could not hold off MEGHA in deep stretch but did hold onto second place in a good effort. PRIZE FEVER settled towards the rear running off the rail, launched rally coming five to six wide top of the lane, closed willingly grabbing third place in last strides. IT'S TIFFIN TIME rated traveling in the second flight, came between foes in mid stretch mounting a mild bid, was outgamed late vying for third place. DID YOU KNOW stalked the runner up from the start, loomed giving chase around the final turn, had nothing left by mid stretch and gave way besting rest. HOB NOBIN well placed stalking the pace to the far turn, gave chase along the rail form the quarter pole, began to fade in mid stretch, no factor. PYRRHIC SECRET unhurried early and trailed at the half, managed to pass a couple of weary foes in the lane but failed to factor. GLOW GIRL GO raced in mid pack to the far turn, had no response when asked for more, faded from upper stretch. WHOS HOT NOW was forwardly placed saving ground to the half, dropped off near the quarter pole, no factor.
