DANCE FOR MILITARY broke sharply pressing past FLIP FLOP to go clear on the turn, dug in with good response through the lane holding sway to wire. MADLY PADDLIN HOME pressed then chased DANCE FOR MILITARY through the turn, asked for more the final eighth stayed on near mid track for place. FLIP FLOP stumbled leaving the gate immediately rushing hard to join DANCE FOR MILITARY at the top, ceded to rival on the turn continuing on near the rail holding reasonably well late. NEON NIGHTS raced evenly four and five wide lacking surge through the lane. WAR SONG chased the pace racing six wide to upper stretch proving no menace there. CAPITOL PANIC played no factor. JOHNNY HOLLYWOOD away slowly raced seven wide to upper stretch with no improvement. DYNAMIC DINO dropped back on the turn.
