JACKSON ACTION sent hard, angled to the rail, felt pressure throughout, dueled inside of TY BOO soon after the start, exchanged a couple of bumps with that rival in mid stretch, dug in determinedly to prevail under an all out drive. NORTHERN BRIDGE stalked the winner along the rail from the start, closed in at the quarter pole, was not making any headway in upper stretch, angled to the three path inside the eighth pole, surged late missing in a game effort. TY BOO showed good early speed dueling with the winner from the start, exchanged bumps in mid stretch, continued on under strong urging but was outfinished missing in a good try. LUCKY RIVER raced evenly at mid track, lacked needed response when roused besting rest. MY AWESOME AVERY settled along the rail in mid pack, gave chase under urging mid turn, failed to respond weakening in the lane. MAKE SOME SILVER lacked speed running at mid track, showed little. HOTHALFONE was off slowly and soon outrun, raced greenly running well off the rail, never factored.
