Footnotes

THE POTTERS HAND nicely rated, saved ground throughout, asked mid turn, angled to take on BECKON THE KING entering the stretch, took over and turned away SKYEY in upper stretch, then was fully extended to hold off FREEDOM COUNTS nearing the wire under an all out drive. FREEDOM COUNTS well rated, sat patient to mid turn, rallied into the stretch, split foes mid stretch, surged inside to miss in a game effort. SKYEY raced in good stalking position, raced three wide to loom in upper stretch, was turned away and leveled off. AMERICAN CANDIDATE rated leaving the gate, advanced mid turn, angled under a stiff drive in upper stretch, made a mild bid but needed more late. BECKON THE KING rushed to set the pace, opened clear lead at the half, was challenged leaving the quarter pole, dug in to upper stretch, weakened from mid stretch. BENNIE BEN BENNY lagged early on, asked mid turn, angled wide into the lane, gave a belated bid but was no factor. CAP raced mid pack throughout, traveled five wide down the backside, roused but gave little response. HOBERT lacked speed, managed to pass two weary foes in the stretch, never involved. PATRIOT'S SONG hustled to chase the leader to the half, was all done leaving the quarter pole, used up. SAPPHIRE HILL raced mid pack while saving ground, gave way mid turn, well beaten.
