Footnotes

NITE TRAIN was a step slow into stride, hustled along the rail racing mid pack, was put to a stiff drive top of the lane, responded mid stretch and slowly wore down THE RAG MAN in deep stretch, surged clear late under strong handling. THE RAG MAN quickly showed in front, set all the pace running in the two path, was wore down in deep stretch missing in a game effort. FLASHINTHEMEADOW tracked down the backside, bid four wide at the quarter pole, loomed off the winner in upper stretch, would need more late besting rest. FALSE HOPE well placed throughout, raced towards the inside throughout, failed to respond giving chase from upper stretch. LONDON LIAISON settled in the second flight, raced four to five wide around the turn, bid between foes mid stretch, improved placing late but never menaced. THE KAVORKA stalked the runner up throughout, gave chase along the inside turning for home, lacked surge and faded from mid stretch. OH EMM GEE settled in mid pack, came five wide under a drive entering the stretch, lacked response never threatening. ZACH'S SUNRISE lagged far off the pace to upper stretch, showed little. SEE THE THUNDER lacked speed racing mid track throughout, never factored.
