Footnotes

WIDE EYED WANDO well rated advanced on the far turn going clear into upper stretch, digging in from the three path needed all to just hold. PAPPA SONG unhurried early circled out to upper stretch surging in the six path missing on the wire. SOCIAL WORKER away slowly stayed back through the far turn, swung seven wide in upper stretch gave an even finish. PADDY TAP slow early saved ground to upper stretch improving position in the two path. UNIVERSALIS sent hard was hustled on lead to the far turn, began to waver there ceding the lead while the rider briefly lost his irons outside the quarter pole, had nothing left down the lane. MENDING VOWS was never involved finishing up at mid track. CAPOTE BULL tracked the pace edging closer to threaten on the far turn, gave way abruptly along the inside in upper stretch. PROPER RESPECT chased the pace through the backside then folded up quickly on the far turn. FLOOR TRADER tracked the pace for half a mile then gave rapid retreat into the far turn.
