Footnotes

HOW ABOUT ALEXIS rushed hard into the far turn, dueled abreast a pair of rivals racing three wide mid turn, cleared at the quarter pole and angled to the rail, maintained a healthy advantage mid stretch, began to tire late and was kept to task holding safe. CONNIE'S JUNE MOON tracked around the bend traveling a little off the rail, set down entering the stretch coming four wide, closed in on the winner nearing the wire, missed in a good effort. A LITTLE GRAND sent early, vied for the lead running between foes mid turn, chased the winner form upper stretch, was no late threat while besting rest. WHISPERING MISSILE urged from the gate, battled in a three way duel to the quarter pole hugging the rail, could not keep pace from upper stretch, tired inside the eighth pole. PAIGE'S BOOK well placed from the start, stalked a hot pace around the bend, failed to respond when roused, lacked needed surge. ACT OF BEAUTY settled mid pack racing off the rail, was hard ridden traveling four to five wide in the stretch run, failed to menace. FLAME BURNS HIGHER lacked speed racing in the second flight, swung wide upper stretch, failed to factor. TRUE JAZZ was always outrun, never involved. DON'T TELL ME THAT lacked speed, angled to the rail saving ground early on, failed to factor.
