MY MAJESTIC settled in good tracking position traveling off the rail, set down midway on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, took aim on a weakening leader at the eight pole, wore down that rival late to win drawing clear at the finish. MISS RELENTLESS hustled to the front, opened up a large lead leaving the far turn, began to tire in mid stretch, was asked for more but became leg weary nearing the wire and was run down late saving second place. PERSONALIZED rated early, advanced leaving the far turn running in the three path, chased the leader into the lane, leveled off needed more while besting rest. JAMMER'S MAGIC raced five wide down the backside, moved in a bit at the quarter pole, improved placing in the lane but was no real threat. ISABELLARELLA raced four wide into the first turn, trailed down the backside, rallied into the lane but finished evenly late never menacing. HERBIESINHERITANCE flashed brief foot, chased along the rail to mid turn, started to fade leaving the quarter pole. MANIS raced five wide into the first turn, hustled down the backside moving into second place, was all done giving way at the quarter pole finishing weary. BEL AIR BABE raced between rivals down the backside, made an early retreat after a half mile, no factor. VICTORIOUS WYNN dropped off early finishing well beaten.
