BEAUTIFUL RAINBOWS hustled from the gate, pressed early racing inside on the turn, collared PETITE PERFECTION leaving the quarter pole, went clear while moving out to the five path in upper stretch, drew off being kept to task. COWWEGE SAVANNAH broke out and bumped SUAVE MARGIE at the break, settled in the second flight, asked entering the stretch, angled to split foes mid stretch, closed willingly. TIME GAP hustled and pressed going into the far turn, bid to vie while four wide at the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner mid stretch, tired late, hard try. HONEYMOONING raced evenly and off the rail, urged near the quarter pole, gave belated bid, was no real threat. TASHILING rushed to duel early, vied at the quarter pole racing between rivals, was briefly in tight and angled wider entering the stretch, weakened late. PETITE PERFECTION broke sharply, set a pressured pace to the quarter pole, lost the lead and angled towards the inside upper stretch, tired in the drive. BRIEFORBOXERS stumbled at the break, trailed running very wide down the backside, remained wide throughout, improved placing late, never factored. FRIEND STAR step slow to begin, never factored. SUAVE MARGIE was bumped by COWWEGE SAVANNAH at the start, rushed to mid pack, gave way drifting wide upper stretch.
