Footnotes

CITY STRIKE raced up close along the inside, vied for the lead mid turn traveling two wide, moved clear mid stretch, held safe under pressure to the finish. SEA OF CHANGE was a step slow into stride, rushed mid turn and split rivals at the quarter pole, loomed off the winner racing three wide, needed a bit more late finishing a willing second best. STAGE DOOR MISTY settled in mid pack, saved ground around the bend, made a steady advance form upper stretch, closed gamely picking up third place. PRIVILEGED TIGER rushed into the far turn, was bumped by a drifting AACHEN near the quarter pole while vying for the lead, battled to upper stretch, tired late being outfinished for third place. BEAR'S A WINNAH pressed for the early lead, traveled mid track around the bend giving chase, failed to menace in the drive while besting rest. PALLASO moved over to the rail shortly after the start, rallied to a menacing position top of the lane, failed to sustain bid and leveled off from mid stretch. ALPINE THUNDER trailed to top of the lane, swung seven wide upper stretch, showed belated interest nearing the wire but never threatened. AACHEN broke alertly gaining a slight lead, began to drift out mid turn and bumped with PRIVILEGED TIGER near the quarter pole, raced wide from upper stretch weakening in the drive. HASTLE lacked speed racing towards the rear, offered little. SMOOTH EUGENE was quickly outrun racing mid track, never involved.
