Footnotes

POWDERED SUGAR rushed soon after the start grabbing control, set the pace in hand around the bend, urged briefly in mid stretch, won comfortably being ridden out. CHERIES CHALLENGE showed good speed stalking the winner, put to a drive entering the stretch, never menaced but was easily second best in a solid effort. SEAHAG broke a bit outward brushing with TRADITIONALISM, settled in the second flight, saved ground throughout, surged in deep stretch to gain the show position in willing manner. CARMEN CAMACHO broke well but was out sprinted for the lead, stalked racing three wide, lacked rally and was edged out of the show position in last jumps. VERY SUPERSTITIOUS raced evenly at mid track, raced five wide upper stretch, lacked response never threatening. TRADITIONALISM broke a bit in brushing with SEAHAG leaving the gate, raced along the rail tracking the pace, failed to respond in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. BRIGHTIA RUBY was always outrun, offered little.
