Footnotes

MAID OF HONOR away slowly, went unhurried tucked inside through the opening turn, sat patient varying little to the 1/2, fired on final turn, circled out 6 wide into stretch, appeared to be hanging outside the 1/16 pole, found a belated burst surging up in final strides. LOVING FEELING well placed on a moderate pace, tracked while saving ground through the backside, swung 4 wide surging near the 1/4 pole, drifted wide in upper stretch, surged to a late lead, drifting out again under a right handed whip, run down by outside closer in final yards. GOLDEN PENNY rated along in second flight, roused to move leaving the backstretch, advanced 5 wide on final turn, loomed abreast rivals in upper stretch, was unaffected on the outside of a drifting LOVING FEELING, lacked a needed late surge. DIAMOND MINE sent to contest HIGH SILVER on the early pace, wrested a short lead on the backstretch, expanded margin going clear to the 1/4 pole, dug in to outside pressure through the lane, gradually wore down. KID CARROTS hustled close to the front end, followed along the inside entering the backstretch, shuffled back between rivals nearing the 1/2 mile pole, tried a roused bid on final turn, had even response failing to menace late. WHY SO WILD raced evenly at mid pack, angled to the inside from the 1/2, faded back last turn, cut the corner into stretch gaining position, leveled off under a drive. SPECK OF PEACE away slowly, outrun to the stretch, proved no late factor. DELIVER THE GOLD sent to the front end, lost ground stalking 5 wide down the backstretch, extended to bid final turn, folded up in mid drive. HIGH SILVER sent for the early lead, pressed along inside of DIAMOND MINE through the backstretch, extended for more racing to the 1/4 pole, leg weary entering lane giving way there. SLICK DEBBIE reared up briefly at the break, rushed along wide through the backstretch, wavered on final turn folding up at the head of the stretch.
