QUITE SASSY away slowly fired into upper stretch, dueling abreast horses moved out to the eight path extending up at the wire. FANTASTIQUE tracked evenly into the far turn, emerged outside upper stretch pressing between horses battling to the end six then seven wide. FASHION INSIDER well rated gave a steady middle move pressing up to challenge on the far turn, dueled between horses at mid track ceding grudgingly late. CHELSEYS FAN slow early saved ground to upper stretch responding there finishing strongly along the rail. POORTOWN PRINCESS stalked the pace moving closer to threaten into the far turn, put a head in front upper stretch dueling inside of rivals near mid track, would cede the issue late. OSCAR DE LA THORN raced evenly off the pace traveling eight and nine wide through the stretch. LE SONJA sent clear set a moderate pace through the backside, challenged on the far turn would duel along the inside to upper stretch giving way there. SHANANIE'S HONOR was always a step slow staying back throughout. STUNNING ELECTRA stalked the pace through the far turn then gave way while drifting toward mid track in upper stretch.
