TAKE AIM rushed form the gate, dueled in a three way battle running between foes, dug in coming to the sixteenth pole and cleared late winning going away under a stiff drive. M. J.'S COMMANDER hustled into the far turn, raced abreast rivals running three wide around the bend, maintained a head lead mid stretch, could not keep pace with TAKE AIM in deep stretch, battled hard to the wire saving second place. FIRE RIDGE sat off a hotly contested pace, bid four wide turning for home, almost drew even at the eighth pole in a four way duel, was outfinished by top pair coming to the wire, settled for third place. CITY CODE sent hard, battled in a three way duel running along the rail to mid stretch, tired a sixteenth out, good effort. PULASKI COUNTY well placed early, angled out six wide under a drive upper stretch, lacked needed surge. SHADES O RED saved ground to top of the lane, angled to the five path upper stretch, came up empty despite being hard ridden. SELDAN raced mid track throughout, was five wide at the quarter pole, roused to no avail, no threat. ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR was always outrun, dull effort.
