TWELFTH OF OCTOBER was taken in hand from the gate, moved off the rail running in the second flight, made a quick four wide move coming to the quarter pole, headed MANCINI'S SONG in upper stretch, blew by and drew off under a drive to the finish. MOLLIE LIL GIRL settled in good tracking position along the inside, angled out four wide mid stretch, finished willing picking up second place. CHANLILLY LACE unhurried running towards the rear, hit best stride mid stretch, closed with interest gaining the show position. MANCINI'S SONG pressed for the lead, moved clear along the inside at the quarter pole, gave way at the sixteenth pole finishing spent. JUSTIN A STORM raced evenly at mid track, roused at the quarter pole, came five wide entering the stretch, lacked rally. LOOKIN SHARP tracked along the rail, hard ridden leaving the quarter pole, lacked needed rally. LEGAL ROYALTY was always outrun, never involved. MISS WISHBONE sent hard, led briefly, battled to the quarter pole, gave way turning for home, stopped at the furlong marker finishing weary.
