FINAL COPY tracked a trio of dueling pacesetters through the turn rallying while seven wide to draw even in upper stretch, locked up abreast CHIEF WINDSONG a sixteenth out would edge clear late. CHIEF WINDSONG hustled out chased then pressed racing three deep on the turn, joined out the outside by FINAL COPY continued to battle through the lane ceding grudgingly while holding well as second best. FLYINGPALM sent hard engaged the pace dueling between rivals on the turn, extended in upper stretch would wear to pressure late. FIDDLERS PRIDE slow early was swung six wide in upper stretch giving even action under a drive. SUMMER GUIDE was always a step slow finishing wide. SIRR PURR was never involved. AMERICAN MINER was always outrun. KISS MY CASH broke alert pressuring from the inside through the turn, had enough when wilting in upper stretch.
