**Footnotes**

TIMELESS FASHION well placed sat patient off HOLD THE SALT looming through the far turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch got to the pacesetter edging by then holding firm. BLUES STREET unhurried to the half was waiting for room when angling out on the far turn, having a clear path at mid track in upper stretch would respond belatedly salvaging place. GUARDIANOFTHENORTH away slowly was rated through the backside, began to move on the far turn angling five wide with BLUES STREET on the outside shoulder in upper stretch, had willing response the final sixteenth. LEADING ON raced evenly off the pace firing out of the far turn to threaten in upper stretch, gave all late under a drive. GHOST HOUR raced second flight dropping further behind on the far turn, had modest improvement through the lane though remaining no menace. HOLD THE SALT sent clear set a modest pace through the far turn then wilted under pressure in mid stretch. RAHYSTRADA lost ground playing no factor. HOT WINK hustled up early would fold after half a mile. STRATHAM (IRE) was always outrun.
