Footnotes

SILKY CHANTEUS hustled close early, pursued 3 wide through the turn, came 5 wide abreast rivals in upper stretch, gave one final surge to get up on the wire. POETRY IN MOTION broke alertly to press the pace, moved inside of rivals through the turn, edged to a short lead in upper stretch, dug in with good response, grabbed in the final stride. RODEO GIRL broke sharply to the top, worked a short lead through the turn, collared between horses at the head of the lane, weakened the final 1/16. TRUELY TRICKY outrun early, varied little on the turn, had a minor gain at mid track in drive. YOU HEARD ME CART away slowly, was outrun losing ground, continued wide in drive finishing evenly. JANET'S HALFTIME hustled close up inside, dropped off rivals racing on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, had no surge in drive. QUIET MIST hesitated breaking a step slow, was always outrun after. LOUIS THE STRIKER raced evenly at mid pack, gave way into stretch. WAGON RIDE hard ridden from the gate, chased along the inside through the turn, folded up at the head of the lane. OUT RIGHT BRANDY struggled throughout.
