BEAUTIFUL BREW ducked in leaving the gate quickly recovering to sit off AVALON LIGHT tracking through the backside, moved on the pacesetter on the far turn grabbing the lead in upper stretch then digging in near the rail, was becoming a bit weary late finding enough to hold off JOJO JETTIN in the closing yards. JOJO JETTIN unhurried early advanced between horses on the far turn emerging a threat in the four path at the head of the lane, gave steady surge taking a run at BEAUTIFUL BREW in the closing yards. AVALON LIGHT sent clear would set a modest pace through the backside, collared by BEAUTIFUL BREW on the far turn would cede the lead in upper stretch then wear down under a drive. SIGNAL'S TRICK raced evenly at mid pack, roused to lane held position while lacking surge. CASA DE FUEGO tracked evenly through the backside, began to waver on the far turn dropping off at mid track in upper stretch. KENTUCKY KITTY played no factor. FINE NOBLE had little response finishing wide. STEALTHESPOTLIGHT folded up after a half mile. NOT HIS FAULT struggled well back.
