**Footnotes**

FARNO raced in good stalking position, rallied along the rail in close quarters entering the stretch, drew even vying for the lead mid stretch, drew off late under a stiff drive. PERFECTLY PLAYED lagged far off the early pace, came seven wide entering the stretch, received strong left handed stick, hit stride too late, finished fastest of all, just got the nod for the place position, good try. GO JOHNNY GO broke sharply, set the pace to upper stretch, headed from both sides with a furlong to go, fought hard, was no match for the winner and then lost second place in last jump. PAPA FUSE stalked down the backside, raced between foes mid turn, lost position at the quarter pole, angled wide in upper stretch under a stiff drive, needed more nearing the wire. I CANT REFUSE tracked to the far turn, rallied three to four wide mid turn, vied abreast rivals mid stretch, weakened in deep stretch. GATEWAY MOON lacked speed racing mid track, failed to respond, never factored.
