KENNY THE SALESMAN well rated advanced on the far turn, bid four wide upper stretch, surged up near the wire. CLASS AX sent clear set a modest pace, hooked in mid stretch ceded grudgingly in the last yards. DOUBLE JUMP swerved and was bumped at the break, rallied five wide on the far turn, bid then hung near mid track late. TWOBITHUSTLER slow early angled out six wide upper stretch, finished evenly. FRANCONA off slowly rallied past tired ones five wide. VICTORIOUS JET played no factor. MAJOR MOVES stalked through the backside then weakened on the far turn. YEMEN failed to respond. PARTNERSHIP chased the pace then gave way abruptly on the far turn. SWINGING BERNIE flattened out on the backside, was eased down the stretch.
