Footnotes

FUJITA battled in a three way duel racing between foes to the three eighths pole, edged clear top of the stretch, held safe under pressure to the finish. G L KIWI made a slight bobble as the gate opened, quickly recovered, tracked a contested pace around the bend, bid four wide entering the stretch taking aim on the winner, needed more late but surged nearing the wire securing second place. EL WINDO settled mid pack, saved ground throughout, rallied top of the stretch, loomed at the eighth pole, leveled off late and was edged out of second place in last jumps. BLUE LION settled in the second flight, swung seven wide upper stretch, hit stride too late, improved position finishing with interest. MYSTIC CHARGER vied for the lead racing abreast rivals to the quarter pole, could not keep pace from mid stretch, weakened to the wire. SOCA TEMPO raced sluggish to the quarter pole, bid four wide from upper stretch, gave belated action but never menaced. DREW STAR varied little racing inside throughout, never factored. ROVE'S BOY settled in the second flight racing mid track, swung out seven wide in upper stretch, failed to respond, no factor. TONY LANTANA hustled leaving the gate, battled in a three way duel to the three eighths pole, tried getting out near the quarter pole, dropped off to trail by mid stretch, well beaten.
