KALEDOSKOP laid close early, gave a prompted middle move going clear into the far turn, drew away down the lane winning as much the best. HARPERS LAND stalked the early pace, gained ground on the far turn, bid five wide in upper stretch responding as a clear second best,. ELLENBERGER PARK slow early advanced on the backside, bid three wide in upper stretch losing some momentum late finishing evenly,. NEXT KITTEN tracked the pace through the backside then faded on the far turn, circled six wide in upper stretch had no recovery. SOONER HUMOR bucked missing the break, rushed outside pressed the early pace then tired,. MIDNIGHT LEGACY chased the pace for half a mile then tired,. CAME TO SCORE was always outrun,. KING HARRY pressed the pace for half a mild then wavered on the far turn giving way to upper stretch,.
