Footnotes

FAULKWOOD SHORES made the lead shortly after the start, set sharp splits throughout, headed by PROVE MEGUILTY near the quarter pole, fought hard receiving strong encouragement, held that rival safe to prevail being fully extended. PROVE MEGUILTY stalked the winner from the start, gained to draw even entering the stretch, could not get by in the drive, held place position in a hard effort. THE ALCOVA KID rated to race towards the rear to the far turn, angled and quickly gained racing four wide on the bend, took aim on top pair in upper stretch, did narrow the gap at the finish, game try. MOON IS A STAR unhurried early, urged mid turn, mounted mild bid entering the stretch while improving position, leveled off besting rest. DULANSKY raced in mid pack traveling between foes at the half, angled to the rail turning for home, slightly improved placing, no threat. UNBRIDLED REBEL raced up close stalking the leader running along the rail, began to chase under urging mid turn, lacked response and faded in the drive. SIRIUS BLACK was hustled from the gate, rushed bid going down the backstretch running four wide, gave way near the quarter pole. AMBER DUBAI was outrun offering little.
