Footnotes

WARRIOR WITHIN sat patient in the early going, asked and quickly gained mid turn, collared WILD GOOSE CREEK near the quarter pole, drove clear turning for home, held safe advantage being kept to task. FORMAL TESTIMONY well placed early, split rivals top of the stretch, angled towards the inside mid stretch, surged willingly proving second best. PRIVATE COSMO broke out and bumped MOONSHINE MAN at the start, settled in the second flight, came seven wide top of the lane, closed strongly in deep stretch. WILD GOOSE CREEK rushed from the gate, duelled down the backside, headed by the winner at the quarter pole, proved no match from mid stretch, weakened late. ALRIGHT NOW unhurried early racing along the rail, was angled out sharply in mid stretch, improved placing. NEVEREVERYIELD broke outward, settled in mid pack, followed the winner mid turn, chased under a stiff drive top of the lane, flattened out mid stretch. CALL THE RAISE was hard used pressing for the early lead, chased for the quarter pole, was all done fading mid stretch. LATENIGHTOFFICER was rushed along the rail soon after the start, vied briefly, gave way entering the stretch. MOONSHINE MAN was bumped and taken up leaving the gate, trailed throughout never factoring.
