Footnotes

ROSA PANTERA raced evenly in the three path through the backside, advanced to contention on the far turn angling to mid track in upper stretch surging late to get a nose up on the wire. CHALLENGER stalked the pace two wide turning up the pressure into the far turn, wrested the lead in upper stretch then dug in from the three path missing in the last jump. KAYAKER well placed stalked along the inside looming from the two path through the far turn, angled out four wide in upper stretch continued to respond giving all to the end. SMOOTH TANGO hustled clear from the gate set an inside pace to the far turn, engaged there battled into upper stretch extending late coming up a bit short. EL WINDO tracked the pace through the far turn coming five wide in upper stretch, hard ridden at mid track lacked a closing surge. HIGH SIGN lost ground early, came five wide to upper stretch lacking a late response. JOHN MEDICA raced three wide failing to menace. DONERAILE'S PEAK saved ground mounting a mild bid on the far turn, dropped from contention in upper stretch. SURGE PROTECTOR sluggish throughout was swung seven wide in upper stretch. DELONGSHOT was always outrun racing seven wide through the lane.
