Footnotes

DANCENSING broke sharply taking an immediate lead, set all the pace, turned away a threatening ALGEIBA inside the eighth pole, increased margin under strong handling. ALGEIBA stalked the winner from the start, angled out taking aim in upper stretch, was turned away with a furlong to go, held place in a willing manner. BOY G. settled in mid pack, angled inside in upper stretch, hit best stride too late, surged late gaining third place. ASISA'S ASSAULT stalked the winner around the bend, lacked needed punch in the stretch run, was edged out of the show position nearing the finish line. BILLY'S DILLYBAR lacked speed racing in the second flight, mildly improved placing but was no real threat. SENOR SMILEY stalked early on running between foes mid turn, hard ridden giving chase top of the stretch, lacked response and weakened in the drive. MR RICHMOND SIR lacked speed traveling in the second flight, varied little despite being hard ridden. MAGICAL BRAVADO lacked speed racing along the inside, offered little never factoring.
