**Footnotes**

MO CUISLE was patiently ridden in the early going, traveled mid track around the turn, came four wide top of the lane, surged strongly in deep stretch to win going away. PATEL MOON was squeezed and steadied briefly leaving the gate, rushed a three wide move mid turn, cleared and angled to the rail entering the stretch, was put to strong left handed stick from mid stretch, proved no match in last jumps holding second place in a solid effort. SPEEDSTER broke out bothering PATEL MOON at the break, rushed hard vying for the early lead, dueled to the quarter pole racing between foes, chased the runner up into the lane, needed more late besting rest. DENALI SILVERTRICK was brushed by AWAASSIF a couple of times shortly after the start, settled in the second flight, swung five wide upper stretch under a stiff drive, improved placing but needed more. BARGAIN BASEMENT tracked around the turn, came three wide racing between rivals top of the stretch, lacked needed punch and tired inside the eighth pole. DANCER SPIRIT broke a bit outward then was sent hard vying for the lead, battled to mid turn racing along the rail, began to fade turning for home. CARLOTA GARCIA (URU) flashed brief foot pressing the early pace, started to weaken leaving the quarter pole. AWAASSIF came in brushing DENALI SILVERTRICK several times shortly after the start, dropped off near the quarter pole, trailed in the stretch run.
