Footnotes

FLY ROBIN FLY broke sharply taking immediate control, turned away a challenge from SUMKIN at the quarter pole, drew off from upper stretch being kept to task. FALCON'S FOLLY rated early and trailed down the backside, roused from mid turn, bid between foes upper stretch, finished strongly picking up second place late in a good effort. SUMKIN was a step slow into stride, raced wide down the backside, rushed bid mid turn, loomed off the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away by upper stretch, was outfinished nearing the finish line fighting for second place. BURNING TWITCH settled early running mid track, gave chase racing in the four path turning for home, lacked needed kick besting rest. JULIE'S CADICE raced evenly along the rail down the backside, was in tight and steadied at the three eighths pole, waited to top of the lane, angled out and was put to strong left handed stick, gave belated action but never menaced. DUNWOODY GIRL lacked speed racing towards the rear, mounted a mild bid running six wide top of the lane, soon flattened out. BYE BYE FOR NOW was forwardly placed from the start, was all done in upper stretch racing three wide, weakened to the finish line. SCARLET BALL flashed brief foot, angled to the inside causing the rider of JULIE'S CADICE to steady mid turn, faded from the quarter pole. DAILY GRACE raced up close stalking the winner to the far turn, dropped off leaving the quarter pole, used up.
