Footnotes

MICROSCOPE broke well, backed off duel entering turn, loomed to 1/4 pole, angled out entering lane, fired when asked, drew off driving. FOW KI WEE came away alertly, set a sharp pace, dug in for drive, proved no match late. TEETOR ON OVER laid close up, tracked on turn, fully extended lane, no menace late. AVARITA slow early, labored to 1/4 pole, 5 wide lane, passed tired ones. PIRATE'S SECRET dropped back, always outrun, improved position late. K'S LASSIE outrun early, never involved. KILIM hustled outside, pursued hard on turn, wilted top lane. BET TOO off a step slow, rushed inside, flattened out mid stretch. DONNA FIRST evenly early on, retreated on turn, empty. LADY LA RUE labored well back.
