NORTH MEADOW prompted the pace through the turn dueling between horses into upper stretch, digging in to outside pressure found more in the two path drawing out while shifting to the three slot late. RAINBOW CLUB stalked the pace through the turn bidding between horses upper stretch, in close brushed with STARLITS TOUCH a sixteenth out giving all to the end in the four path. STARLITS TOUCH broke slowly and was bumped at the break, hurried in pursuit drew even three deep upper stretch, extending at mid track was brushed by RAINBOW CLUB a sixteenth out digging in to stay on to the end. SKYLIGHT WARRIOR slow early rallied six wide to threaten in upper stretch, looming outside a trio of rivals would hang late. LEX VISION a step slow off the pace finished evenly at mid track. MEACHEM ROAD broke sharply pressing and chasing through the turn, wavered in upper stretch dropping off along the rail. GO FAR FITZ dropped back on the turn. LONG SHOT LUKE was always outrun.
