**Footnotes**

SWEET BUMP came out slightly at the break squeezing LOVERS LANE, hustled to the top pressing on the inside of COLDRIDGE MIA, dueled angling between horses in upper stretch, drew clear driving. BUCKSHOT SLEW hustled close up at the break, loomed off a trio of pacesetters through the turn, set down abreast rivals in upper stretch, gave even response late needing more. MISS ACCELERATION dropped back in close quarters early, remained outrun through the turn, came 4 wide to upper stretch, responded with a belated burst. COOLRIDGE MIA swerved in leaving the gate, pressed outside of SWEET BUMP while lugging in on the turn, dueled at the rail into upper stretch, wore down the final 1/16. LOVERS LANE squeezed between horses checking at the break, dropped well back laboring through the turn, gave willing response under a drive to finish well. ROCOCO dropped back early, trailed through the turn, came 8 wide to stretch, had no improvement. NO MORE TAX hustled along off the pace, lost ground through the turn, weakened into stretch. ALLIED DANCER broke alertly to go on the pace, dueled abreast rivals on the turn, extended into upper stretch, folded up in drive. GATA BE WILD sent hard in early pursuit, faded back racing on the turn, wilted into stretch. HAWAII PROSPECTOR a step slow early, tired into stretch. A stewards inquiry was followed by an objection from the rider of LOVERS LANE against the rider of SWEET BUMP citing interference shortly after the break, The objection was upheld and SWEET BUMP was disqualified and placed fifth.
