RUSSIAN KITTEN pressured the pace through the turn shaking clear in the three path upper stretch, angled toward the rail while holding firm. TOOL TIME GIRL sent hard pressured the pace through the turn, ceded to RUSSIAN KITTEN in upper stretch angling out from the two path to the four slot securing place. THUNDER OF HOPE in hand early pressed up to challenge on the turn, extending in the four path down the stretch gave an even finish. ABITA INDIGO away slowly saved ground to upper stretch angling to the three path while improving a bit late. WEEKWEE chased early pressing up to challenge on the turn, wavered in upper stretch dropping off at mid track. LAUGHTER'S JOY lunged at the break rushing up to recover pressuring the pace through the turn, would wear out in upper stretch.
