THE ALCOVA KID unhurried early traveled four wide advancing on the far turn, came six wide in upper stretch bearing down abreast SNEAKIN THRU edging by late. SNEAKIN THRU stalked then pressured the pace shaking off BE BOPPIN WYNN to wrest a short lead in upper stretch, engaged from the outside by THE ALCOVA KID dug deep to no avail. YOUNOHOWIAM well rated gave a prompted four wide move to threaten out of the far turn, was angled inside when looking for room in mid stretch finishing evenly. SHOW ME THE CASH in tight at the break raced five wide throughout giving an even move in upper stretch holding position late. LOFTY AND NOBLE raced evenly throughout finishing up at mid track. HOT WINK tracked the pace through the backside racing along the inside to upper stretch, had little left near the rail. SILVER JAZZ struggled at the back to the far turn, was swung seven wide in upper stretch. AMBER DUBAI in close at the break would labor throughout. BE BOPPIN WYNN sent clear worked the pace under pressure to the far turn, began to waver there giving way along the rail to upper stretch. UNBRIDLED WISDOM veered out crowding rivals at the break, stayed back to the far turn, was steadied off heels into upper stretch ducking out eight wide.
