Footnotes

HURRY HOSS stalked early pressing up to grab the lead on the turn, widened in the three path upper stretch holding sway while angling in a bit late. THE BIG MAN tracked the pace through the turn coming five wide upper stretch, gave a late push at mid track saving place. HOMERSRUN broke sharply setting the early pace, ceded to HURRY HOSS chasing that one into upper stretch, extending in the four then three path down the lane would hang late. OWEN THE TIGER raced mid pack through the turn coming five wide in upper stretch, angled in to the three path while holding position late. MOON CAT chased early then dropped off on the turn racing six wide through the stretch. FLASHINTHEMEADOW a step slow throughout raced seven wide down the lane. SAINTLY TALE brushed in close quarters with FEAR OF NOTHING at the break, stayed back through the turn coming eight wide in upper stretch. FALSE HOPE flashed early speed then gave way on the turn. BIG HEARTED DON was always outrun racing seven wide down the stretch. FEAR OF NOTHING in close brushed with SAINTLY TALE at the break, would labor after.
