Footnotes

I'M TATER stalked then pressed GHOSTLY GIN VISION around the turn, matched strides from upper stretch, put a head in front a sixteenth out, prevailed under an all out drive. DI COLAS GIRL raced up closed running along the rail, waited a bit near the quarter pole, angled out four wide entering the stretch, brushed lightly with IRISH PEGACY in upper stretch, vied inside the eighth pole in a four way battle, finished willingly and settled for the place position in a game effort. GHOSTLY GIN VISION broke sharply and angled to the rail, headed by the winner on the turn, fought hard throughout the stretch run, yielded grudgingly nearing the wire missing in a hard effort. IRISH PEGACY made a slight bobble at the break but quickly recovered, hustled up tracking the pace, came five wide into the lane, loomed from mid stretch, hung in last jumps despite being hard ridden. COUNT YOUR PENNIES was crowded briefly when I'M TATER came inward shortly after the start, settled towards the rear, angled inside turning for home, improved but was no real threat besting rest. DEVONS PRECIPIENCE raced evenly in the second flight, came five wide under a drive top of the stretch, lacked response, no threat. FOREST TIGER LILY raced wide down the backside, offered little. J. J.'S DEVIL was forwardly placed in the early going, gave way leaving the quarter pole. CASEY'S GIRL dull effort, never involved.
