**Footnotes**

MR. BOURBON STREET rushed down the backside, vied early on with MISTER ANDERSON, matched strides to top of the lane, edged away moving out to travel in the three path, was kept to pressure holding safe to the finish. MISTER ANDERSON raced up close from the start, drew even and put a head in front at the quarter pole racing four wide, remained a threat to the finish but was outgamed late and held willingly saving second place. CAN'T SPELL settled early, rushed between foes mid turn, angled towards the rail upper stretch, was outgamed late vying for second place, game try. KYLE'S TREASURY tracked throughout saving ground, lacked response when roused besting rest. BRIEF NOTE forwardly placed early tracking the pace, came three wide between rivals top of the stretch, lacked rally. HESALUCKYBLUFF settled early, rushed a four to five wide move coming to the quarter pole, loomed off a pair of duelers, failed to sustain bid leveling off mid stretch. CELTIC FIRE pressed the winner down the backside, chased form mid turn under urging, faded from upper stretch. NO RISK NO GAIN was quickly outrun, passed a coup-le weary rivals but never factored. WHENTHEDEALINSDONE was always outrun, showed little. SAY AGAIN lacked speed racing wide throughout, offered little in a dull effort.
