VIOLET EYED DIVA had good early position, sat patient along the rail down the backstretch, hooked KEEN SCENT as the pair entered the stretch, went head and head in close quarters down the lane, gutted it out to prevail in last strides . KEEN SCENT came away alert, pressed to a short lead on backside, kept margin to 1/4 pole, collared from the inside upper stretch, battled in close quarters before ceding late . JEANIE SUE was slow from the gate, varied little to the second turn, circled wide into stretch, mustered a late response to improve position . REGAL BLUES well back early, trailed the field to the 1/4 pole, had some belated action but was no real threat . ONE EYED JACKIE bumped and crowded leaving the starting gate, raced evenly through the second turn, gave a mild bid upper stretch and leveled off . MS ISADORABLE veered in bumping MS ISADORABLE leaving the starting, unable to make the lead chased KEEN SCENT from off the inside, wore out entering the stretch faded back . HAITIANREITERATION remained second flight, failed to mount any bid . NATASHA PUMPKIN showed early speed, prompted the pace to the 1/2 mile pole, empty from there . ALLOCATION hustled on the outside, lost ground throughout and tired upper stretch . THERE RUNS HATTIE was always outrun and tired .
