DONNIE LEE broke sharply wresting a short lead then working the margin through the turn, shook off JUST CALL ME MR K into upper stretch holding safe late along the inside. THUNDERING REPOUR off slowly was circled out leaving the turn coming six wide to upper stretch, surged steadily in drive cutting into the winners margin while salvaging place. FAPPIE'S BOOKMORE chased under prompting through the turn, extended in the three path down the lane needed more late. GRUBBY'S GIFT sent hard pursued while saving ground to upper stretch, would waver late racing near the rail. RIGHT ON QUEUE raced evenly off the pace, improved modestly in drive. HIGH SIGN showed some early speed then gave way to upper stretch. TULSA TIME lost ground to upper stretch, folded under a drive. JUST CALL ME MR K sent hard pressured DONNIE LEE on pace through the turn, dispatched in upper stretch had little left late. BEST PAL LOUIE was always outrun. TURN OF THE SCREW showed little.
